

Course Terms & Conditions

Please may we draw your attention to the following:

- Payment of your bookings is acceptance of our terms and conditions.
- Full payment per person is required to secure the booking & we require 30 days' notice for any amendments.
- A four-person deposit is required for any bookings between 5-59 players. Where the group size is 60+ we require a £500 deposit.
- The office reserves the right to alter a tee time(s) or offer a full refund if required.
- All tee times are in nine-minute intervals and are based on playing in four balls. We
 reserve the right to make any tee time up to a four ball, and/or pair up on the day of
 play.
- METAL SPIKES are NOT permitted at Machynys Peninsula Golf Club & Premier Spa.
- It is the responsibility of each group to keep up with the speed of play. Proper golf shoes must be worn, and the dress code adhered to (please find the dress code below). It is the responsibility of the organiser to inform his/her guests of this. It is the responsibility of the organiser to ensure that his/her guests are aware of the standard etiquette of golf. Failure to comply with this will result in the individuals concerned being removed from the golf course.
- Traditional golf attire is applicable on the golf course.
 - All shirts must have a collar
 - Tailored shorts only
 - Short socks are permitted
 - Denim wear, jeans, round neck tee shirts, football/rugby style shirts and casual shorts are <u>NOT</u> permitted on the golf course.
- The Club House has a soft spike policy and is relaxed on clothing attire pre and post golf (i.e. jeans are acceptable in the Monks Bar & Brasserie).
- Please note we do not provide towels at the clubhouse.

- In the unfortunate event that you have to cancel, we regret payment is neither refundable nor transferable.
- Use of golf buggies by the golf day participants will be require to sign our buggy waiver and he/she will be liable for any damage incurred to the buggy or the course.
- Machynys Peninsula Golf Club & Premier cannot accept any liability or responsibility for loss or damage to belongings. Persons wishing to leave belongings on the premises do so entirely at their own risk. Furthermore, Machynys Peninsula Golf Club & Premier Spa cannot accept any liability or responsibility for damage or injury to any visitor, or their property.
- In the event of the guest's behaviour being unacceptable, the Management reserves
 the right to insist upon the offending individual(s) immediate departure.
 Furthermore, the client undertakes to pay all reasonable costs incurred in making
 good any breakages or damages resulting directly or indirectly from the behaviour or
 conduct of the client or the client's guests.

Weather Policy

Lightning

- In the event of bad weather, please take note of the below to understand how this might affect your booking.
- In the event of lightning, golfers out on the course should cease playing immediately after the sound of the horn. Retreat to the nearest shelter or building, until the immediate lightning threat has passed. If it is safe to do so, golfers may then return to their places on the course and complete their rounds.

Heavy Rain

- If the course is closed due to adverse weather conditions, you will be entitled to transfer to an alternative date at the appropriate golf rate, subject to availability.
- Unless the course is closed, it is up to the discretion of the player as to whether they wish to continue/start their round when it is raining. If chosen not to play, no refunds or credits will be issued.
- On occasions we may need to restrict the use of trolleys and/or buggies. A DAILY
 decision is made by the Course Manager as to whether or not trolleys and/or buggies
 will be permitted on the course (weather dependent). Please call The Professional
 Shop (01554 744888) from 7am onwards on the day of your booking for this
 decision.

Frost

• Golfers are advised that should there be a morning frost, there may be a delay to starting the round or the use of temporary greens. All delays and changes to tee times will be communicated with those playing, but the condition of the course will be the main priority when making the decision to allow play.
